Domestic Burglary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 1st phase of target hardening now complete with 30 properties in Newhall and Midway having been fitted with full alarm systems ➤ 2nd phase about to commence in Newhall and Woodville. ➤ 3rd phase of target hardening also about to start on sheltered housing using memo minders etc. ➤ funding being allocated to assist the persistent offenders project ➤ Community Drugs Officer researching the availability of current drug referral and treatment services in South Derbyshire.

Anti-social Behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Public meeting held in Linton, local residents have agreed to basketball facilities being provided for young people. ➤ Audit report completed for Risk Assessment Pilot. ➤ Sub group formed to consider feasibility of BMX/Skateboard facility ➤ Sub group formed to complete feasibility of Neighbourhood Warden Scheme ➤ Sub group formed to consider establishment of Mediation Service ➤ Security Marking kits to be issued to all young people on playschemes
Substance Misuse	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Operation Night completed with 21 arrests made and 90 crimes recorded. ➤ Community consultation in Newhall completed and report produced. ➤ Youth Service mobile outreach facility progressing and full programme due to be available from the end of September. ➤ Community Drugs Officer now in post. ➤ CAD programme 02/03 approved by the Strategic Group.

<p>Violent Crime</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Mark Hughes (DCC) confirmed as Strategic Chair. ➤ Next meeting scheduled for 30 September 02 ➤ Successful test purchasing pilot held in urban core of Swadlincote. Two out of 15 shops failed test. Prosecutions are pending.
<p>Community Engagement</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The Action Team has been established and is working on a range of actions including: ➤ Annual programme of crime prevention campaigns ➤ Conference and Seminar programme ➤ Communication Strategy completed, awaiting agreement from Partnership members.
<p>Domestic Violence</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Domestic Abuse Awareness Conference held June 2002. ➤ Funding secured for capital build of Safe House. ➤ New full time post appointed at CVS to work with children and families experiencing domestic abuse.
