1.0 Purpose of Report

To consider the appointment of a representative to participate in meetings regarding a new waste disposal contract for Derbyshire,

2.0 Detail

- 2.1 For several months, officers from local authorities in Derbyshire have been working together on the procurement of a new waste disposal contract for the whole of the county.
- The next stage in the process consists of a small number of preferred suppliers making presentations to members and officers on how such a contract might work.
- 2.3 The original intention was for the Council to be represented by Cllr Southerd, Chair of the Environmental and Development Services Committee. However, Derbyshire County Council and the City Council, which operate the 'Cabinet' model of decision making, have indicated that they will be represented by both the Portfolio holder and a member of a Scrutiny Committee. (This is because both Councils are conducting a parallel Best Value Review of their waste management services.)
- 2.4 Although, this Council operates under a Committee system, a similar arrangement would seem to be sensible.
