Objection under Licensing Objective
Prevention of Public Nuisance

The application by Crange field asks for Music & Dance from 11:00 AM to 1:00 AM and similar for serving alcohol and food. If this venue is still operating at full capacity at 1:00 AM then vehicles will be entering and leaving for a considerable period after this 1:00 AM shut down.

The music/dance licence request till 1:00 AM seems also likely to create nuisance despite the planning application claim that rooms will be soundproofed.

Operating till 1:00 AM for 365 days per year will have a detrimental effect on the village of Lees/Trustley and Longhams and Astleston.

Other nearby venues are licensed till 11:30 PM for alcohol music & carriages. I do not see why this application should be significantly different.

If possible please suggest alterations to the application that would resolve the problem mentioned above, again paying attention to the licensing objectives

An 11.30 pm cut off would seem more appropriate to keep this application in line with other similar venues nearby
