LOCAL INTERVENTION PROJECT

1.0 Recommendation

To note the proposal to develop an action plan which supports work in those communities with relatively higher levels of deprivation.

2.0 Purpose of the Report

To propose the development of an Action Plan targeted at communities in the District that have relatively high levels of deprivation as identified in the Indices of Deprivation.

3.0 Details

Following the inclusion of targeted work in the Health and Wellbeing Plan and discussion at the last Board meeting about services in areas of highest deprivation in the District, and predominantly the urban core, it is proposed to initiate some work to tackle this issue.

Appendix No.1 contains the 2010 Indices of Deprivation that identifies those communities in the District which suffer the greatest levels of deprivation in Derbyshire and nationally. Using this data the Safer South Derbyshire, Health and Wellbeing and Sustainable Development Theme Groups along with organisations represented on the South Derbyshire Partnership Board will propose actions that can be delivered in localities aimed at reducing the issues identified.

In terms of financial support it is proposed to allocate an initial £5,000 from the Partnerships reserve fund to support these projects and provide added value to the public health funding being allocated to work in these communities through the Health and Wellbeing Plan.

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
