This matter is one in which I have declared a personal interest because I have been named in letters from the Atkin family solicitor. I declared that personal interest after having sought advice from the Standards Board for England.

This problem has understandably caused distress to the Atkin family. It is causing unpleasantness in the village. It has also been very disruptive for the Parish Council which now finds itself inquorate and therefore unable to discuss the issue.

I believe that the Council needs to find a way forward from this position; needs to be able to discuss the now several letters from the Atkin solicitors and hopefully bring a closure to the situation.

Therefore I am requesting that the Standards Committee of South Derbyshire District Council grant me a dispensation from my interest in order for me to take part in discussions and return the Council to a quorate position.
