REFERENCE:**

1.0 Recommendations

- 1.1 That the Committee note the ideas submitted during the recent campaign and determines any specific requirements you may have for the period 2007/10.
- 1.2 The Committee considers any specific actions it wishes to progress in the short term and makes such appropriate recommendations to the next meeting of the Finance and Management Committee where finance is required for those proposals.

2.0 Purpose of Report

- 2.1 To inform the Committee about the responses to the 'Ideas into Action' Campaign and make recommendations to Finance and Management Committee for progressing those ideas in relation to this committee responsibilities.

3.0 Detail

- 3.1 Following the recent 'Ideas into Actions' Campaign the summary report was considered by Full Council on the 9th November. A copy of that report with its Annexes is attached to this report at Annexe A.
- 3.2 That report lists all the ideas submitted and, in Annexe 1 to the report, groups some of them into key issues with proposals that could be progressed relatively quickly.
- 3.3 It is not proposed to repeat the detail of that report here but the Council resolve that all Policy Committees should consider the ideas submitted and make recommendations to the Finance and Management Committee meeting on 30th November 2006 regarding the proposals they wish to bring forward both in the short and the longer term. There is a possibility that a limited amount of funding may be made available by the Finance and Management Committee for short term proposals that require one off or low level funding.
